Position Objective

The plant operator is required to undertake a diverse range of operational activities and be focused on the delivery of quality outcomes on a professional and timely basis. The leading hand is responsible for leading and directing the work of his or her immediate work team, setting a superior example to achieve production and related targets whilst not compromising the health and safety of yourself and those under your supervision. The leading hand is required to set up and run plant, operate ancillary plant, and coordinate production as required, being focused on the delivery of quality outcomes in a safe, professional and timely basis.

Key Responsibilities and Duties

The key responsibilities and duties may be modified from time to time to ensure that desired outcomes are in accordance with the operational requirements and organisational needs of Mibus Bros (Aust) Pty. Ltd. Without limiting the above, the key responsibilities and duties of the position will include:

- Operate a variety of plant including wheel loaders, excavators, dozers, scrapers, graders (incl. final trim / GPS / Rover) in an effective and efficient manner, in line with company policy and work standards
- Complete daily checks and maintenance on machinery operated, ensuring the company's plant and equipment is maintained to a high standard
- Develop and maintain positive relationships with new and existing clients, delivering a quality service to the client
- Be aware of and comply to all company policies and OH&S requirements
- Undertake duties in a manner that is safe and without risk to health, and ensuring a safe workplace for self, all staff, and visitors
- Using, handling, storing, and transporting all plant, equipment, and substances correctly
- Be involved in and complete Mibus Bros (Aust) Pty. Ltd. Integrated Management System systems and procedures as directed including completing accurate field records, daily logbooks, and timesheets
- Participate in all aspects of Chain of Responsibility (COR) requirements
- Other duties within skills, knowledge and experience

Leading Hand Level 1, 2 or 3

As a Leading Hand you will engage in and be responsible for managing construction activities. The ideal candidate will have a solid background in civil construction, excellent leadership skills, attention to detail and a strong commitment to ensuring that projects are completed safely, efficiently, and to the highest standards.

Supported by the Manager and Supervisor you are expected to:

- Be the site Mibus Bros representative, developing and maintaining positive relationships with new and existing clients as well as delivering a quality product for the client, as a profitable service
- Plan for and manage the day-to-day operations team, operating plant as required and directing the work of the plant operators. This includes wheel loaders, excavators, dozers, scrapers, or crushing plant in a safe, effective and efficient manner, in line with company policy and work standards

- In collaboration with the Operations Manager and other workshop staff, ensure that the company's plant and equipment is maintained to a high standard and ensure that routine checks and services are undertaken, undertaking minor repairs and maintenance onsite. Ensure all faults or services are conveyed to the workshop manager through direct contact or through the Operations Manager
- Conduct site WHS assessments, investigations, daily pre-start / toolbox meetings, SEWMS/JSEA reviews, provide WHS data and ensure all company policies and Environmental, Health and Safety requirements are met including:
 - undertaking duties in a manner that is safe and without risk to health, and ensuring a safe workplace for self, all staff, and visitors
 - using, handling, storing, and transporting all plant, equipment, chemicals, and substances correctly
 - setting an example for, and ensuring staff under your supervision comply regarding correct PPE usage and safe work methods
- Supervise and coordinate daily activities of construction crews, ensuring tasks are completed on time and to specification.
- Provide on-site leadership and guidance to team members, fostering a positive and productive work environment.

Confidentiality
